

MAKNA Cancer Research Collaboration Fund 2022 Application Terms & Conditions for Institution

Theme: "Patient-centered Research"

Area of research/Category: 1) Cancer prevention – Behavioural science in cancer prevention

2) Cancer prevention - Biomarkers and early detection/diagnosis

3) Cancer treatment - Precision medicine

1 Objective

The aim of the MAKNA Cancer Collaborative Fund is to promote cancer research among local scientists.

2 Eligibility

Application is open to all Malaysian citizens with a medical specialist degree or PhD from an eligible institution of higher learning (public or private), hold a permanent or fixed-term contract until the grant end-date, residing and pursuing cancer research in Malaysia.

3 Application Procedure and Requirements

All applications should be made on the application form, which has been provided to the respective institution. A Turnitin or plagiarism report must be attached with the research project proposal in one (1) pdf file. All required information should be stated clearly and concisely. Any resubmission from the previous application should be revised and updated.

All applications will be submitted to the respective institution for first round of filtering. Only 2 top applications from each institution will be submitted to MAKNA at research@makna.org.my by the respective institute.

4 Selection criteria by institution

The respective institution may use their selection criteria to select the top 2 applications that fit the themes and area of research/category.

Each institution can only submit 2 applicants to MAKNA before the deadline.

5 Application duration

The call will be opened by 1st April 2022. Deadline of submission from the institution is by 31 May 2022.
